What Does “End Of Life” Mean?



This includes software, virus protection and other vital components. With the Windows 7 lifecycle ending, it is recommended that operating systems be upgraded to Windows 10.

It is important to understand that your PC will still run on Windows 7, however at the turn of the year it may be more susceptible to viruses and security breaches. These vulnerabilities could compromise your network and overall operations.



The updated on-screen guide is now bigger, bolder and easier to read. Along with several new features, Cobalt TV provides an even more informative and user-friendly TV experience.

- Use a round or oval table to give guests a better view of one another.
- Be sure rooms are properly lighted. Faces should be easy to see with no glare.
- Keep background music and other sounds to a minimum.
- Seat guests with hearing loss with their back to the wall for better acoustics.
- Seat supportive people next to individuals with hearing loss to fill in parts of the conversation that get missed.
- Have a few board games on hand that don't rely heavily on hearing, such as:
 - Monopoly
 - Jenga
 - Double Ditto
 - Scrabble
 - Apples to Apples
 - Charades
